

PREPOSITIONS OF MOVEMENT

REVIEW: Use the chart below to review the three main prepositions of time.

TO	INTO	ACROSS
MOVEMENT IN THE DIRECTION OF SOMETHING	MOVEMENT FROM OUTSIDE TO INSIDE	MOVEMENT FROM ONE SIDE TO THE OTHER SIDE
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • GO TO SCHOOL • GO TO THE PARK • GO TO A CIRCUS • GO TO BED 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • INTO THE ROOM • INTO THE POOL • INTO THE BED • INTO THE TRAIN 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ACROSS THE STREET • ACROSS THE HALL • ACROSS THE ROOM • ACROSS THE LINE

NOTE: The idea of movement may be used with all three prepositions.

Example #1: Brush your teeth and go to bed.

Example #2: Watch me jump into the swimming pool.

Example #3: My house is across the street from the library.
