Introduction

In this activity, you will learn about Wh-questions. These questions start with words like who, what, when, where, why, and how. You will practice making your own Wh-questions based on different situations.

Here are some words to help you:

- Scenario: A situation that could happen.

For example, a scenario might be finding a lost dog.

- Question: A sentence that asks for information.

For example, "What is your name?" is a question.

- Information: Facts or details about something.

For example, knowing the time is useful information.
